



## **FIRE WARDEN**

**Length of course: ½ Day**

### **Is this the right course for me?**

This course is designed for anyone who needs to develop their basic fire safety awareness and those who may have a designated responsibility for workplace fire safety as a Fire Warden/Fire Marshal. This course provides the knowledge that will allow them to carry out duties relating to fire safety and emergency procedures.

### **Pre-Course Requirements**

There are no formal requirements for learners who want to take this course although some knowledge of basic fire awareness may be useful.

- Fire risk assessment
- Fire safety inspections
- Role of a Fire Warden

You will learn by listening to talks, group discussions, course related in-class activities and question and answers plus practical exercises with extinguishers.
